**KEVIN** 







#### THE TRAIN KEEPS ROLLIN'

Officially opened in December of 2022, Engine House Café is the newest shop on the block from a couple of already well established local business conductors.

Brook and Melissa. owners of the new coffee shop on Queen Street in Killaloe are thrilled to bring their dream of a café serving their locally roasted coffee to life and have been overwhelmed by the support they have received from the community and newcomers to the area.

Melissa says "it's about community, that's why we do it! It's not about making money, it's about creating something for the people that live here and supporting our economy. This is a special place and the community aspect: how we support each other and how everyone is accepted for who they are makes us proud to call this place home and encourages us to keep going."

Brook and Melissa own three other businesses in Killaloe; Grandma's Pantry, Engine House Coffee and the Mix Company. Melissa says they knew they wanted to build a café when they built the new Grandma's Pantry in the old Killaloe Sports Plus building in 2020 and are excited to see it all coming together. Future plans include brining the roastery into town and eventually building outdoor seating for the coffee shop.

Brook and Mellissa are also heavily involved with the Killaloe BIA and have donated to many local causes in the community.
