Each 4 person team will play three six-end games during an 8 day period. Our Drawmaster will try to schedule

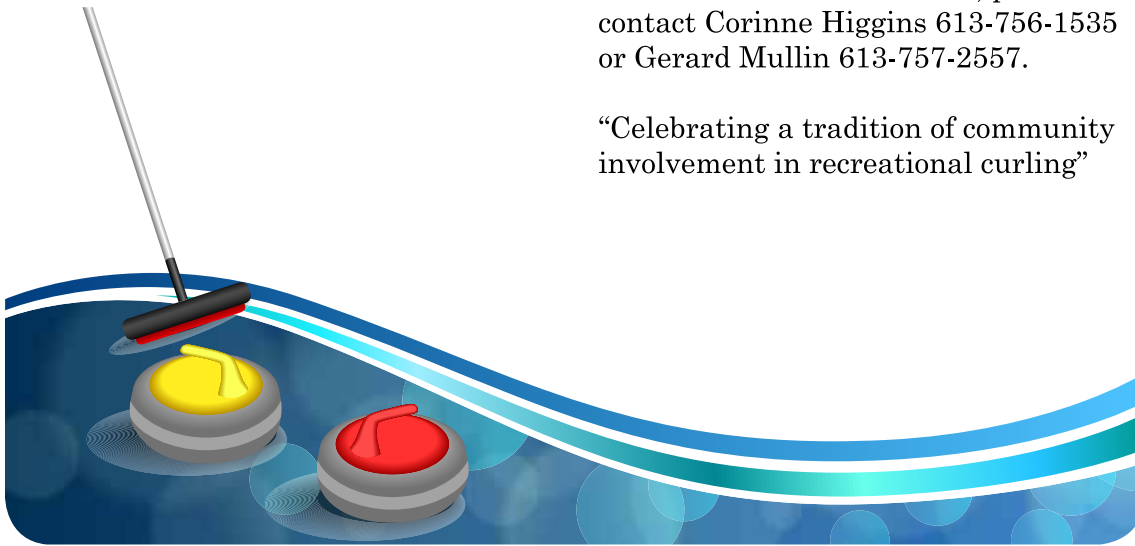
games to suit work and personal commitments.

If you are getting married this year, you will need a marriage licence. The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards issues marriage licences. You need to make an appointment to obtain your licence and you need to bring the following: a completed Marriage Licence Application Form (available in the office or on our website), you and your spouse will each need two pieces of ID and you need to pay the prescribed fee of \$75. If either party is divorced, a copy of the original divorce decree is also required.
