## January 6, 2009

## **Public Meeting**

The Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with Councillors Isabel O'Reilly, Kathy Marion, Ernie Cybulski, Stanley Pecoskie, Carl Kuehl and Debbie Peplinskie present. Mayor Janice Visneskie chaired the meeting, which she opened and called to order.

**<u>Pecuniary/Financial Interest:</u>** No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any of the council members present.

**Purpose of Meeting:** Mayor Visneskie advised that the purpose of the meeting is to discuss By-Law #01-2009, being a by-law to amend By-Law #18-94, being the Zoning By-Law of the former Corporation of the former Township of Hagarty & Richards, as amended, to provide for the zoning of certain lands located in Part of Lot 20, Concession 6, Geographic Township of Richards, from Tourism Commercial – Exception One (TC-E1) to Limited Service Residential-Exception Four (LSR-E4) and Limited Service Residential-Exception Four (LSR-E4) an

Mayor Visneskie asked if all necessary notices have been complied with, and was told by the CAO/Clerk-Treasurer that they had. Mayor Visneskie opened the floor for discussion. Mayor Visneskie advised that a letter had been received from MNR outlining their objection to the amendment, as they had concerns relating to occurrences of Species at Risk in close vicinity of the proposal. Mr. Dunne was in attendance and objected to the complaint on the basis that MNR did not provide adequate information as to the kind of Species at Risk that they were referring to in their letter. He also advised that the proposed zoning amendment will lessen any impact of the property, as it will be used for residential purposes rather than commercial purposes, as is currently the case.

Mayor Visneskie informed council that the objection from MNR had been received on January 6, 2009. The Notice to Public Bodies that had been sent to MNR in regard to this proposed amendment had asked for a response by December 21, 2008.

No council member supported the objection from MNR. Full council agreed to approve the proposed zoning amendment.
