The Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with Councillors Isabel O'Reilly, Kathy Marion, Ernie Cybulski, Stanley Pecoskie, Carl Kuehl and Debbie Peplinskie present. Mayor Janice Visneskie chaired the meeting, which she opened and called to order.

<u>Pecuniary/Financial Interest:</u> No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any of the Council members present.

<u>Purpose of Meeting:</u> Mayor Visneskie advised that the purpose of the meeting is to discuss By-Law # 27-2009, being a by-law to re-zone certain lands located in Part of Lot 25, Concession 4, Geographic Township of Richards from Limited Service Residential (LSR) and Tourist Commercial – Exception Four (TC-E4) to Residential One (R1).

Mayor Visneskie asked if all necessary notice have been complied with, and was told by the Deputy CAO/Clerk-Treasurer that they had.

Mayor Visneskie opened the floor for discussion and informed the public of Section 34(11) of the Planning Act as follows: "If Council decides to refuse an application or refuses or neglects to make decision on an application within 120 days of the municipal clerk receiving an application or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality." Section 34(19) of the Planning Act states that "Not later than20 days after the giving of notice of passing of the by-law, the applicant, any person or public body who made oral submissions at the public meeting or made a written submission to Council before the by-law was passed, or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality.
